WHO WE ARE

Transition Spain Experience, Ltd. stands out as a top provider of Spanish immersion and learning programs for teenagers, with a focus on **Transition Year** and **Leaving Certificate** students, **school groups** and **online Spanish lessons.**

Since 2022, we have been running successful programs in **Granada** and expanded to **A Coruña**. Students have the flexibility to choose either location or combine both for a richer experience of Spain's varied cultures, customs, and culinary traditions.

Parents and students consistently highlight our program as one of their greatest experiencies, as it offers an in-depth and well-rounded perspective on Spanish **life**, **language**, and **culture**.













Granada ranks among the most popular destinations for international students, welcoming nearly 60,000 of its 240,000 inhabitants each year. Its sunny weather and the unique tradition of free tapas with drinks make dining out a cultural highlight. Thanks to its prime location—just 40 minutes from the snowy peaks of Sierra Nevada and the beaches of the Costa Tropical—Granada offers outdoor adventures throughout the year. Not to mention the Alhambra Palace, which is the most visited monument in Spain!

A Coruña, also home to around 240,000 people, lies along the historic Camino de Santiago, a famed medieval pilgrimage route. This vibrant coastal city features stunning beaches and holds the record for the longest seafront promenade in Europe, stretching 17 kilometers. Known for its exceptional food scene and as the birthplace of fashion giant Inditex (Zara, Bershka, Pull & Bear, Mango, among others), A Coruña has a lively and stylish atmosphere!























The network of Spanish host families is well-structured and stays in close communication with the coordinators of the language programs. These families have extensive hosting experience and renew their clearance certificates each year through the Spanish Ministry of Justice, following the official vetting procedures for hosting minors.

When assigning students to families, we carefully consider individual needs such as medical requirements or dietary restrictions, as well as personal preferences like proximity to friends or a gym, having young children in the home, or shared interests.

Our goal is to create a warm "Home away from Home" where students feel safe, comfortable, and welcome.











LANGUAGE PROGRAMME

Our language programs follow a **Content and Language Integrated Learning** (CLIL) approach, where carefully guided activities play a central role in language development and cultural skills acquisition.

All lessons are led by native **Spanish-speaking teachers**, and Spanish is the primary language of instruction to maximize exposure and listening comprehension. English is used when necessary, to clarify explanations or solve students' questions.
