Language Programme

Our language programmes are based on **Content and Language Integrated Learning** where **supervised activities** are key to language acquisition and tailored to group age, level and student objectives.

Weekends

Free time with peers and host family. Students are encouraged to actively participate in the daily lives of host families (set the table, chat to them at mealtimes, etc). A group **excursion** is organised at least once per month (e.g. beach trip, mountain trek and adventure sports).

(*) Examples of midweek activities:

Cooking, dance, music or photography workshops, guided tours of the city and emblematic sites, sports (football, padel, hockey, etc).



Host Family Accommodation

The Spanish Host Families form a well-organized network who are regularly in contact with the language programme coordinators. They are experienced host families and submit annual certificates from the Spanish Ministry of Justice in accordance with the vetting process to accommodate minors.

Host Families generally accommodate 2 or 3 students in a **twin or triple** bedroom. Depending on availability/location/season, some families may accommodate individuals.

Students and host families are allocated bearing in mind priorities (medical conditions, dietary restrictions, etc.), preferences (near to friends or gym, young kids, similar hobbies, etc.) and with the common objective of providing a comfortable, welcoming Home from home
